

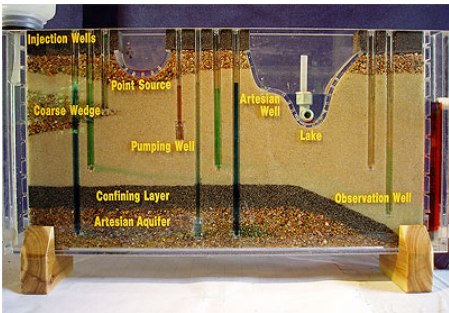
Resource Lending Program

Groundwater Model – Students learn about water as it travels underground!



Tabletop Stormwater and Wastewater/Drinking Water Models – Students set up the landscape, create pollution or waste and watch what happens when it “rains”!



Macroinvertebrate Pack – Students use magnifiers, ID cards and tools to examine water bugs up close in a river, stream or lake!



Incredible Journey Dice Game – In this popular Project WET activity, students travel as a water drop around the earth with the roll of a dice!
