

ARCHERY RANGE
Boise Parks & Recreation Department
Rules & Regulations

PURPOSE

The purpose of this rule is to establish regulations to govern the conduct of patrons at the archery range owned and operated by Boise Parks & Recreation Department. These regulations are designed to promote health and safety of the City's archery range patrons. A copy of the rule shall be prominently posted at each facility to which it applies.

AUTHORITY

Boise City Code 13-01-04 C. 1
Boise City Code 9-14-04 C

REGULATIONS

1. Archers shall shoot only at designated targets.
2. Archers shall shoot only from shooting line.
3. Archers shall ensure that the area is clear before shooting.
4. All archers must be done shooting before arrows are retrieved.
5. All children under twelve (12) shall be under adult supervision.
6. Archery range is open from sunrise to sunset.
7. Archers shall treat the archery range with respect, pick up trash and leave the area cleaner than upon arrival.
8. All competitive events must be approved by and scheduled through the Boise Parks & Recreation Department.

ARCHERS SHALL NOT:

1. Use broadhead arrows.
2. Use crossbows.
3. Use paintball guns or firearms of any sort.
4. Use personal target butts.
5. Use alcoholic beverages within the boundaries of the archery range.
6. Allow pets within the boundaries of the archery range.
