

# JULIA DAVIS PARK

700 S Capitol Blvd

(86 Acre Regional Park)

Julia Davis Park is a community park located along the Boise River just south of downtown. The park may be accessed from S. Capitol Blvd on the west and from 3rd Street, south of Myrtle.

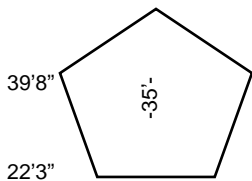
**RESERVABLE:** Pavilion #1, Pavilion #2, the Rose Garden, Gene Harris Band Shell and Zoo Boise (See Zoo Boise Narrative for info.) (Private Rentals or Community Events)

**PAVILION 1:**  
**Boise Pavilion**  
**CAPACITY:** 500/seating capacity 80.  
**Tables:** Thirteen (13)-3'x3' pedestal seating; two (2)-6' serving; concrete slab  
**BBQ:** Two (2) small grills  
**Power:** Eight (8)-110v outlets, one (1)-220v outlet; with 20 amp breakers; Lighted Facility  
**Water:** Drinking fountain; utility sink; Hose Bib not available to public.  
**\*Beer & wine products and/or amplified sound allowed ONLY with reservations and by permit.**

**PAVILION 2:**  
**Agriculture Pavilion**  
**CAPACITY:** 500/seating capacity 90.  
**Tables:** Fifteen (15)-6' seating (seating for approx. 90)  
**BBQ:** Double BBQ grill  
**Power:** Two (2)-110v outlets; Lighted Facility  
**Water:** Drinking fountain by restrooms  
Easy access to the Rose Garden, Zoo Boise and the Greenbelt  
**\*BEER/WINE PERMITTED WITH RESERVATION AND PERMIT ONLY!**

**ROSE GARDEN:**  
**CAPACITY:** 150/Ten (10) - 5' seating benches in gazebo area. Moving benches is not allowed. **Chairs are discouraged, but up to ten (10) may be used for physically challenged guests; Chairs must be hand carried into the park. Please No Chairs on the Turf.**  
**Tables:** None  
**BBQ:** None  
**Power:** Not Available  
**Water:** None

**BAND SHELL:**  
**CAPACITY:** 1500  
**STAGE SIZE:** Depth; 35', Width; 22'3" narrowest, 39'8" widest  
**Tables:** None; for Community Events Only.  
**BBQ:** None  
**Power:** Thirty-six (36)-110v outlets and one (1)-220v outlet; 20 amp breakers. Lighted by fourteen (14) pole lights and six (6) stage lights.  
**Water:** There is a hose bib under the stage.  
**NOTE: Access to behind stage area requires scheduling and Park Staff on duty.**  
**\*ALCOHOL PROHIBITED!**



**OTHER FACILITIES/** **Drinking Fountains:** Six (6); Four(4) wall and two (2) free standings located at Shelter 1, Shelter 2, Rose Garden, Zoo Boise and throughout the park.

**AMENITIES:**  
**Playground:** Northeast side of park near Shelter #1, behind Zoo; appropriate for children 2-12 years old  
**Recreations:** Zoo Boise, Boise Art, Historical, and Black History Museums, (Paddle) Boat House, Discovery Center, Boise River and Greenbelt; six (6) tennis courts, sixteen (16) horseshoe pits and two (2) bocce courts. BBQ facilities and seating tables are dispersed throughout the park for drop in use.

**RESTROOMS:**  
**Between Rose Garden and Bandshell:** Seven (7) stalls for women and two (2) stalls/two (2) urinals for men.  
**Pavilion #1:** Three (3) stalls for women and two (2) stalls/one (1) urinal for men.  
**Pavilion #2:** Four (4) Unisex and two (2) ADA accessible stall  
(All restrooms are lighted and are open mid April to mid October.)

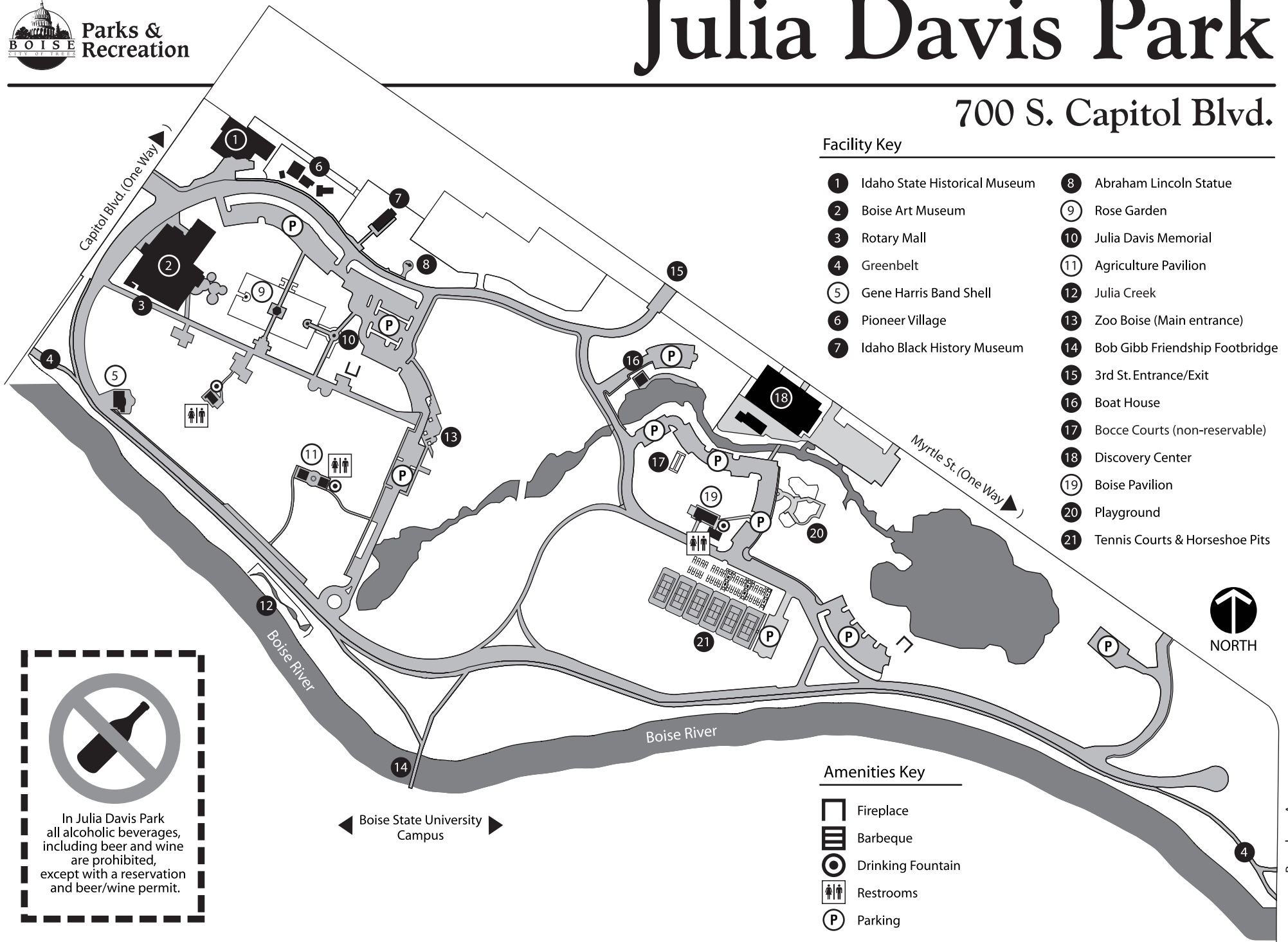
**PARKING:** Approximately 491 spaces, includes marked roadside parking throughout the park and 28 ADA accessible spaces. Parking is limited to designated areas and is available on a first come first serve basis.  
**THERE ARE PARKING RESTRICTIONS AT THIS PARK FROM SEPTEMBER THRU MAY; LIMITED TO TWO (2) HOURS, 7:00am - 4:00pm. NOTE: Vehicles parked in NO PARK areas will be towed at owner's risk and expense. Boise Valley Towing 389-9707.**

**PUBLIC PHONE:** Located inside at Zoo Boise, the Boathouse, the Historical and Art Museums.

**\*Accessible Areas:** Parking, unloading areas, routes to primary entrances and routes to sites. Access to Bandshell and restrooms - Shelter # 1: drinking fountain, restrooms - Shelter #2: parking area – tables, restrooms, and playground.
