

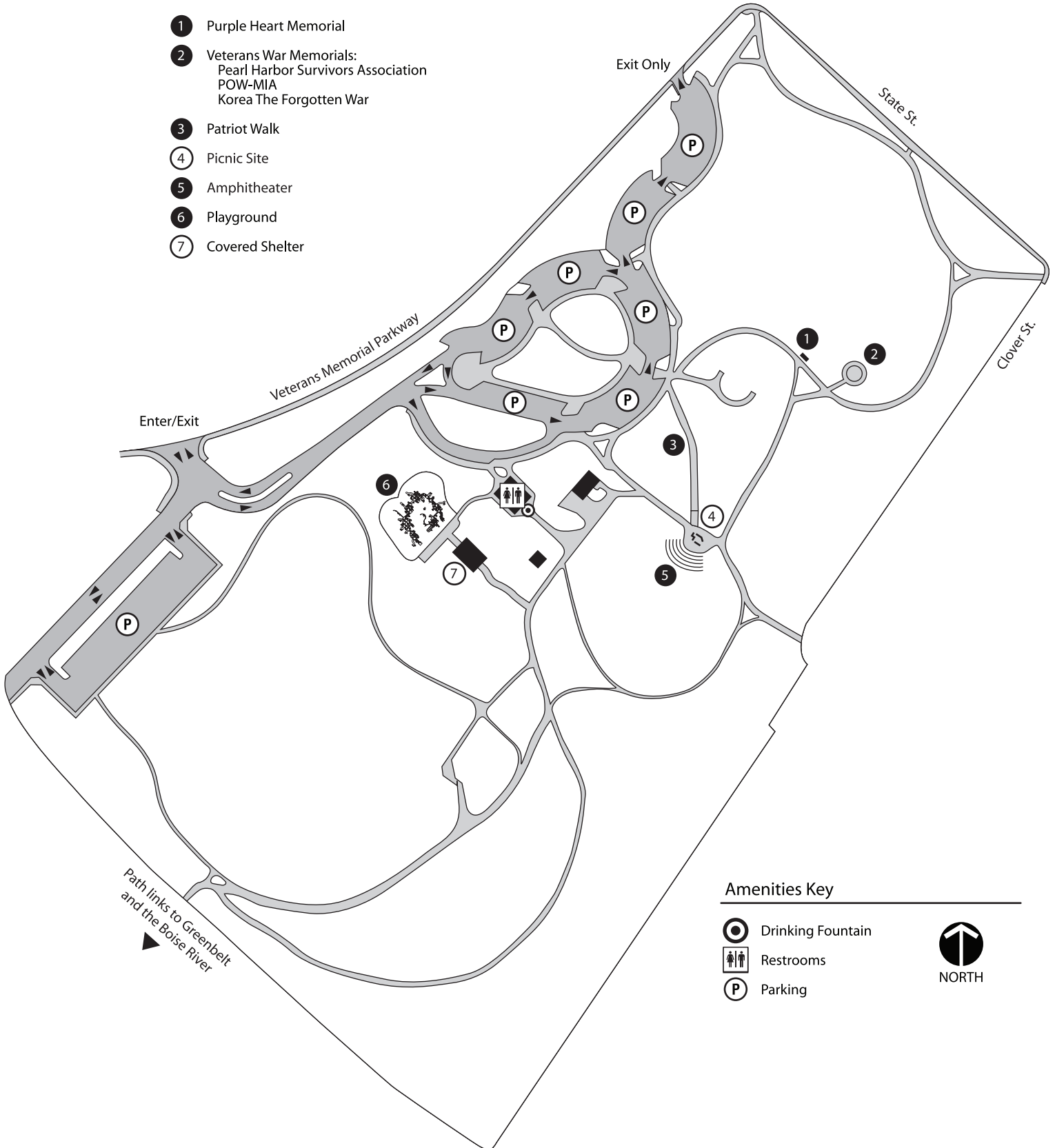


# Veterans Memorial Park

**VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK**  
**930 Veterans Memorial Parkway**  
(79 Acre Special Use Park)

Veterans Memorial Park is a Special Use park located in a central area of Boise, SE of State St & Veterans Memorial Parkway.  
(East on State St. - right on Veterans Memorial Parkway. Park entrance is on the left.)

- RESERVABLE:** Picnic site area east of maintenance building. Shelter on the SW section of the park next to the restrooms.  
(Private Rentals)
- CAPACITY:** Shelter 200/seating 100, Picnic Site 50/50seating, Entire Park 500
- PICNIC SITE:** **Tables:** Ten (10)-6' seating; approximately fourteen (14)-6' seating scattered throughout the park.  
**BBQ:** None  
**Power:** Four (4) - 110v outlets with one (1) 20amp breaker on stage/sound wall at the program area.
- SHELTER:** 30'x44' shelter is located on the SW section of the park next to the restrooms.  
**Tables:** Three (3) rows 30' long, wheelchair accommodation at the ends of the tables.  
**BBQ:** None  
**Power:** Two (2) boxes, One (1) - 110v outlets and one (1) - 220v electrical outlets.
- OTHER FACILITIES/  
AMENITIES:** **Drinking Fountains:** Located near restrooms  
**Playground:** Southwest of restrooms, appropriate for ages 2-12 years old.  
**Recreation:** Trails and greenbelt may be used for hiking, bicycling, and walking. Non-motorized boating is allowed on the small lake south of the park area. Several access routes to fishing areas along Boise River.
- RESTROOMS:** Southeast of the maintenance building: Five (5) stalls for women and two (2) stalls/three (3) urinals for men. (Lighted and open year round.) Portable rest rooms are located on the east side of Boise Lake from mid April to mid October; (One (1) for women and one (1) for men.)
- PARKING:** Approximately 200 parking spaces - 7 of which are ADA accessible. Parking is limited to designated areas and is available on a first come first serve basis. Additional parking located SW of Shelter.  
**NOTE: Vehicles parked in NO PARK areas will be towed at owner's risk and expense.**

- \*Accessible Areas:** Trails throughout the park to greenbelt along river; five (5) parking spaces; main rest rooms - one (1) stall for women and one (1) stall for men.
