### Boise Mountain Eyecare

Boise Mountain Eyecare implemented a comprehensive conservation plan into their daily activities to minimize energy usage and reduce their carbon footprint. Highlights of Boise Mountain Eyecare's conservation plan include:

- Top-down support and participation in the conservation plan.
- Minimize shipping impacts (ie., use of fossil fuels) by having eyewear shipped directly from the frame manufacturer to the prescription lens lab eliminating their office as the middle stop. And, contact lenses ship from the manufacturer directly to the patient.
- Purchase Energy Star equipment.
- Reduce, reuse, and recycle all paper products, shipping containers, printer cartridges, etc.
- Use a programmable thermostat.
- Use non-toxic cleaning supplies.
- Transitioning from paper records (i.e. medical and insurance claim forms) to electronic records management system, reducing paper use by 90%.
- Incorporated energy efficient designs/standards into their new office building (2008) including Low-E windows and insulation requirements.
- Use of occupancy sensors on all light switches.
- Use of a timer on outdoor lights and signs to conserve energy.
- Use of compact fluorescent lights both inside and outside the facility.
