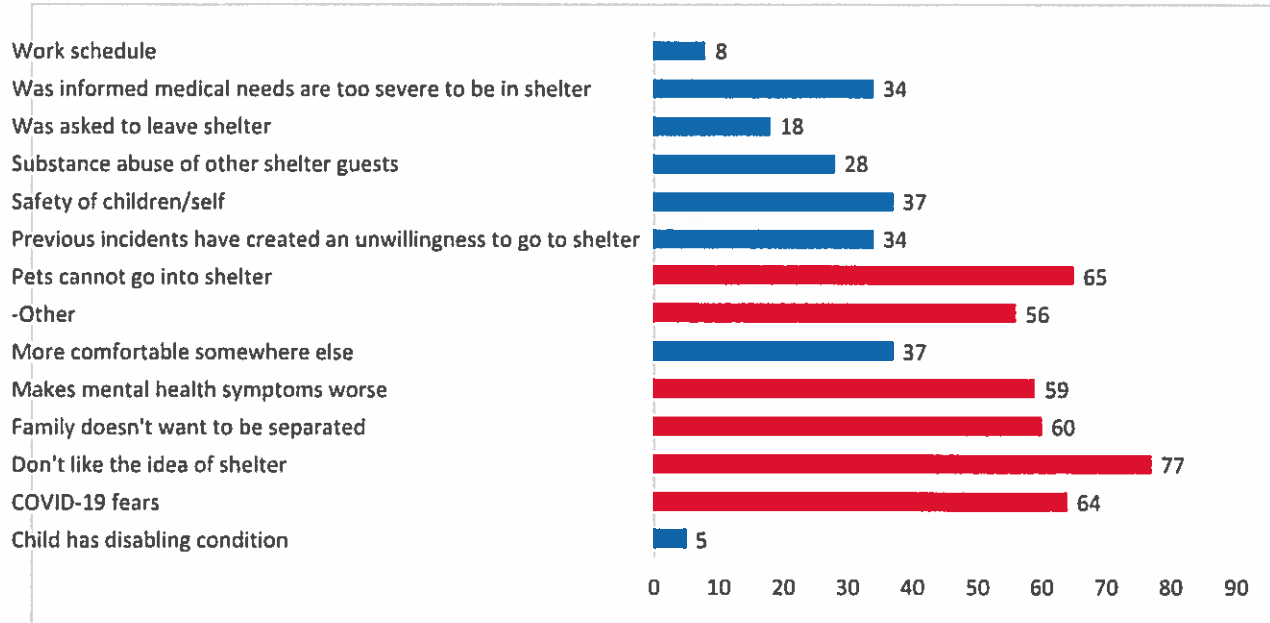


Reasons for Avoiding Shelter – Coordinated Entry Responses

 Things stolen, anxiety, depression
 Has never been in the shelter is apprehensive
 Due to health problems
 and work schedules
 On the waiting list for Hopes door, and WCA
 Has severe anxiety, depression, conversion disorder
 Makes childrens' mental health worse
 impacts kids mental health
 Partner has addiction issues
 Covid19
 covid 19 lockdown, does not want to be in lock down
 Would leave child to go to bathroom and the workers
 threatened to call CPS

fleeing dv staying with mom
 Abuser would pursue taking son

 Can sometimes stay in shelter but has been denied - not

 They want the resource to go to people more in need

Disabling condition	doesn't feel comfortable/accepted in shelter (specifically Interfaith)
Disabling condition	Child has autism, can't go into shelter
Went to shelter for 1 day and got sick	covid 19
Doesn't want to lose Camper-Van	Has substance abuse issues
Nampa Lighthouse mission kicked everyone out	
Addiction sustainability	
Difficulties with admission	
pride and hard to ask for help	
Can't get over there in time	
Don't want to lose Camper-Van	
medical issues

Plan to go to shelter now that warrant is resolved was told shelter has limited availability in summer & wait list was long.
