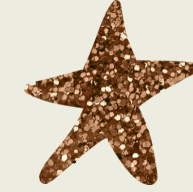
YOU ARE WELCOME HERE

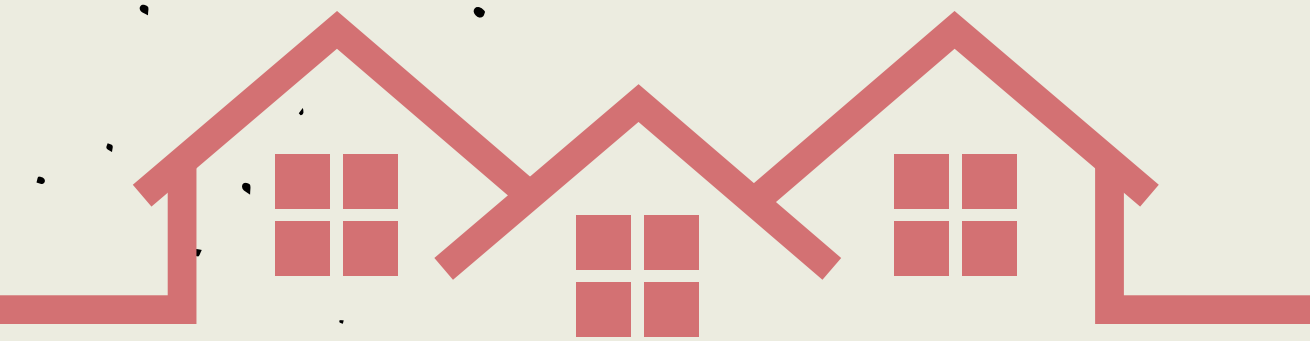

WHY THIS IS NOT SUSTAINABLE...

- **INCREASED STAFFING DEMANDS- 20 STAFF WENT TO 42**
- **LOGISTICS- INCREASE IN TRANSPORTATION NEEDS**
- **INCREASED COSTS IN OPERATIONS- FROM 1 MILLION TO 1.8 MILLION**
- **STRESSFUL TO ORGANIZATION**
