ACCEPTED:

All prescriptions and over-the-counter medications for you and your pet.

NOT ACCEPTED:

- NO BUSINESS WASTE
- No illicit drugs
- No chemotherapy drugs
- No needles, lancets, or pen needles
- No bloody or infectious waste
- No urine or feces contaminated items
- No IV bags or catheters
- No aerosol cans
- No hydrogen peroxide
- No thermometers
- No hair care products or cosmetics
- No mail, batteries, or trash

DISPOSAL GUIDELINES:

- Medications may be bagged
- Do NOT leave items that won't fit in bin drop chute. Ask at counter for assistance.
- Liquids must be in original bottle, capped, and sealed in a plastic bag. Do NOT pour liquids directly into plastic bag or directly into collection bin.
