Notice of Intent to Award Contract: RFP 18-226 Operation of Airport Parking System, Boise Airport

Thank you for your response to the above referenced RFP 18-226.

This letter is to notify you that the City has reviewed all proposals and recommends that the project be awarded to the best qualified proposer, Republic Parking System, LLC.

**Bid Results:** The proposals were opened May 16, 2018 at 2:00 p.m. local time. Twenty One (21) companies received plan sets and were entered on the plan holders list. Five (5) proposals were received. The evaluation team's score results can be found below:

Should the City be unable to successfully negotiate a contract with the top ranked proposer, that negotiation will be terminated, and the next highest ranked proposer will be contacted to begin negotiations.

If any participating bidder objects to such award, such bidder shall respond in writing to the notice from the political subdivision within seven (7) calendar days after the date of transmittal of the notice setting forth in such response the express reason or reasons that the award decision of the governing board is in error.

The protest shall be addressed to the Boise City Purchasing Agent. Any protest addressed to Boise City Mayor and/or City Council will be referred to the Purchasing Agent.
