WILDERNESS WITHIN REACH FLY-IN FOR VETERANS

This rare and cool opportunity is for Veterans who have a physical disability that affects their mobility (those who use a wheelchair, walker, AFO braces, prosthetics etc.) and one friend/family member. At the request of the pilots, priority is given to Veterans with physical disabilities who have not previously gone on a Wilderness Within Reach Fly-In trip.
