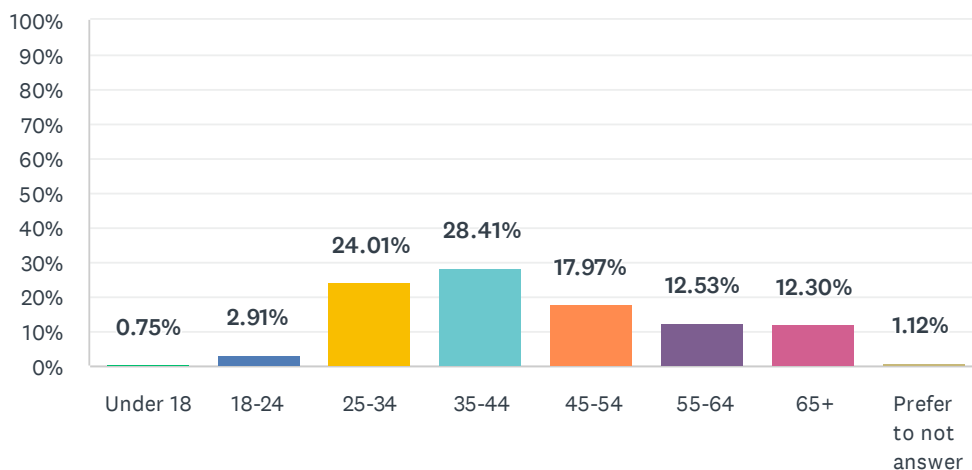


## Q1 What is your age?

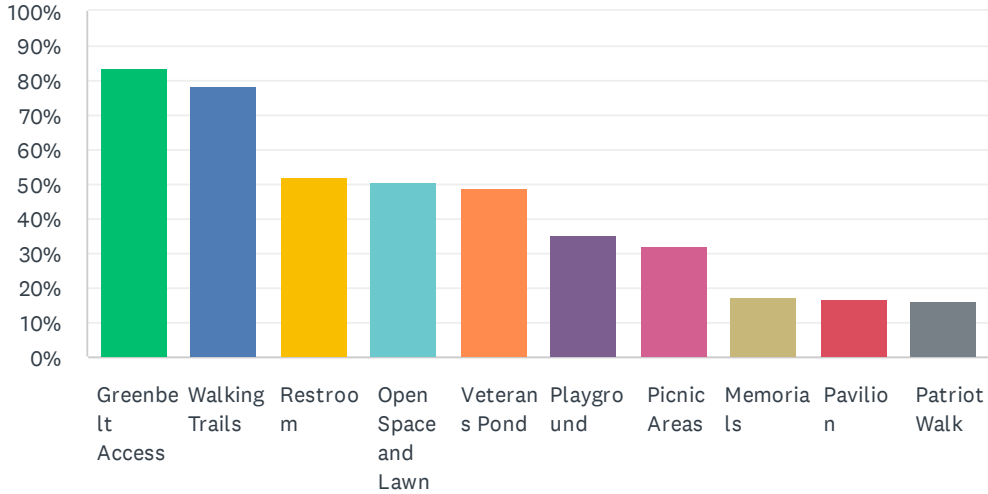

## Q4 What current amenities do you and your family enjoy when you visit the park? (Choose all that apply)

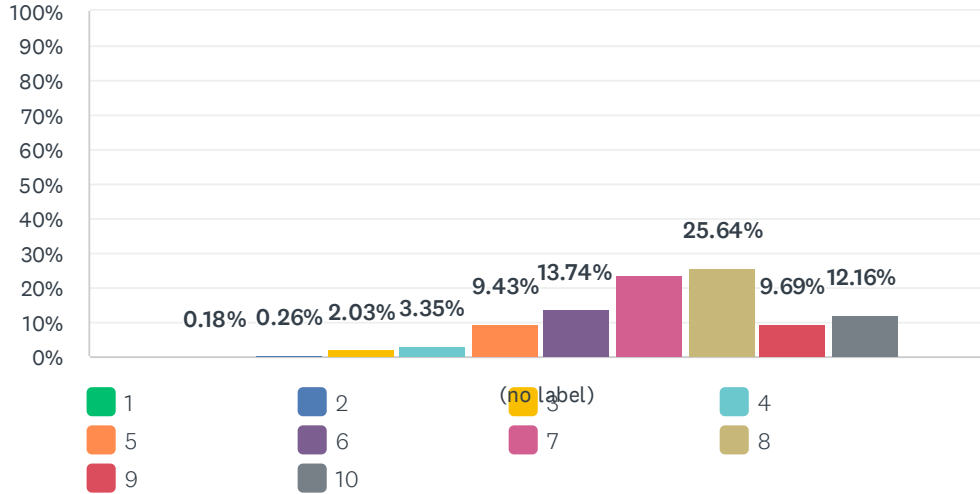

## Q5 How would you and your family rate your most recent visit to Veterans Park (0-10) with 10 being excellent.

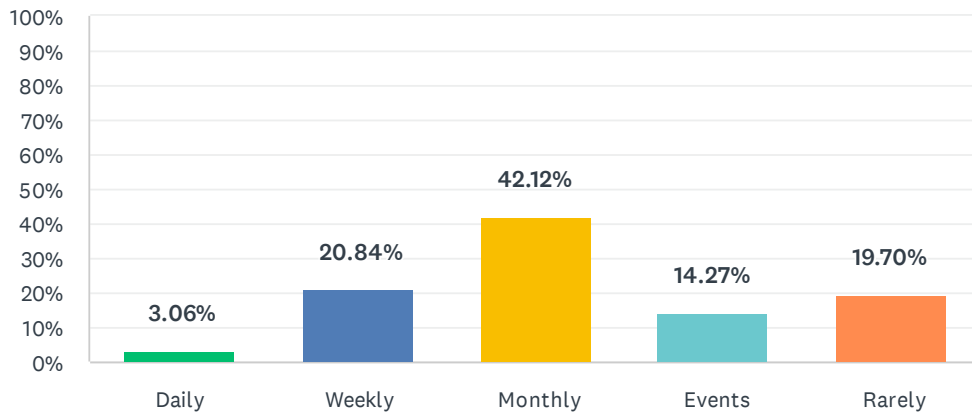

## Q6 How often do you and your family visit the park?

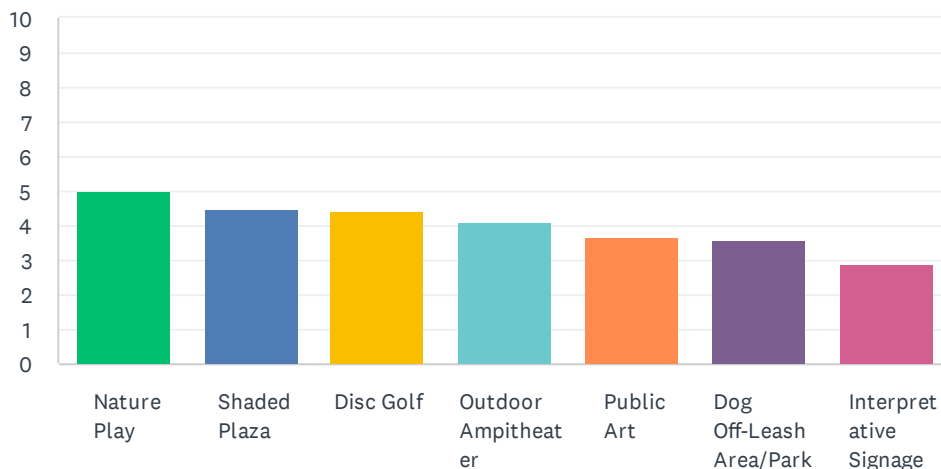
