HOUSEHOLD HAZARDOUS WASTE



Visit our website to find a household hazardous waste collection site near you, where you can bring items like:

- ✓ Automotive products, rechargeable batteries, paints and stains, electronic equipment and small appliances.
- ✓ Motor oil: bring up to 25 gallons to a collection site or place up to two gallons of oil next to your trash cart in clear containers with screw-tight lids, labeled "Used Oil".

GLASS



Visit our website to find a glass drop-off site near you or get a glass recycling cart at home for an additional monthly fee.

- ✓ Drop-off sites accept glass bottles and jars without lids or caps.
- ✓ All glass is recycled locally.



COLLECTION

Trash and compost are collected weekly. Recycling is collected every other week. Visit our website to find your schedule.

HOLIDAY COLLECTION

Expect collection to occur one day later if your regular service falls on or after one of these holidays:

- New Year's Day
- Memorial Day
- July 4th
- Labor Day
- Thanksgiving
- Christmas

No delay will occur when holidays fall on a weekend.

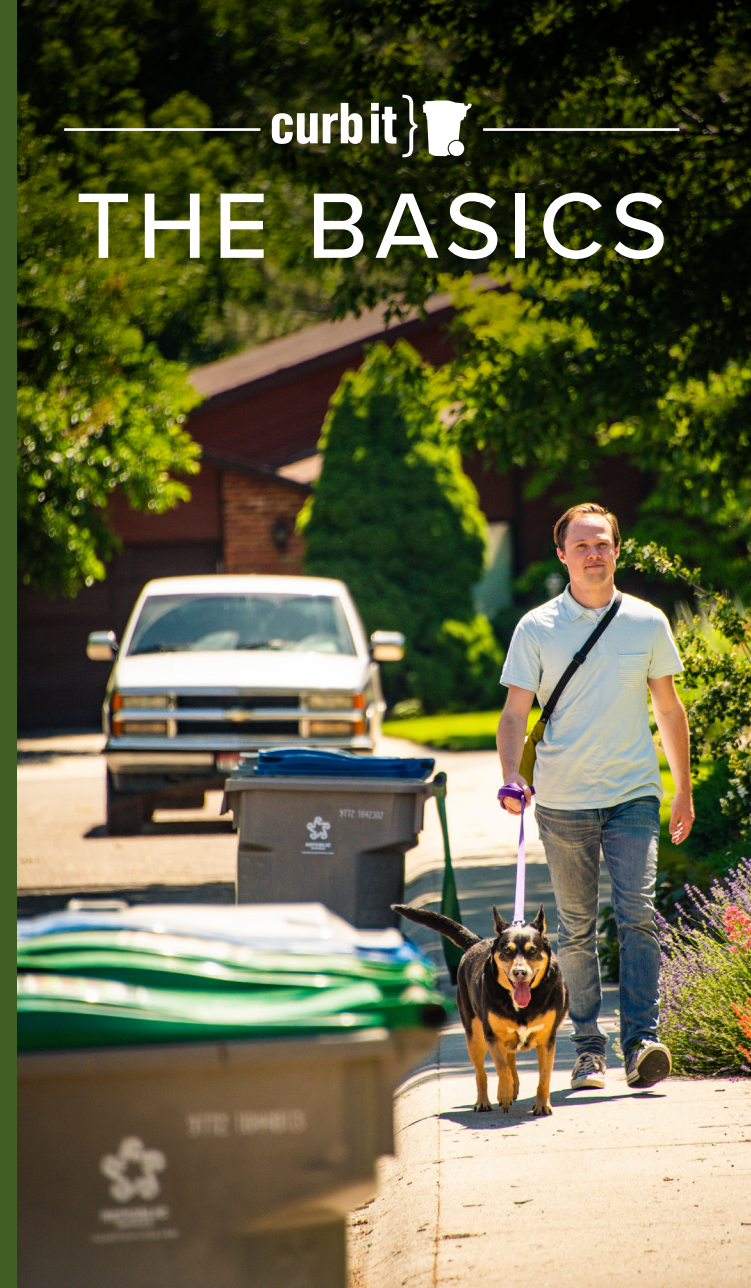

COMPOST

YOUR GREEN-LID CART



Place yard trimmings and food scraps loose in your compost cart.

EXTRA COMPOST: Set out up to 10 paper leaf bags next to your cart each week, all year-round.

YES

- ✓ Yard and garden trimmings
- ✓ Food scraps and leftovers including veggies, meat, bones and grains

NO

- ✗ Plastic bags
- ✗ Compostable products
- ✗ Liquids
- ✗ Pet waste

Your compost service includes access to finished compost for your lawn and garden.

RECYCLE

YOUR BLUE CART



Place clean and dry recycling loose in your cart, not bagged, and always break down your cardboard boxes.

EXTRA RECYCLING: If you regularly fill your blue cart before pick-up, consider getting a second recycling cart. Visit our website for free occasional extra recycling options.

- ✓ Paper, cardboard, metal cans

- ✓ Plastics



Bottles, jars, jugs



Food tubs

NO

- ✗ Plastic bags or garbage bags
- ✗ Glass
- ✗ Clamshell containers
- ✗ Batteries

YES

- ✓ Clean and dry plastics labeled:



- ✓ Plastic bags, wraps and films, styrofoam, plastic cutlery and plastic straws

NO

- ✗ #1, #2 or #3 plastics
- ✗ Non-plastic recyclables such as metal or paper
