Title: Erosion and Sediment Control Program Site Preparation Inspection Policy

Code Name: Boise City Code. Construction Site Erosion Control Ordinance.

Code Sections: 8-17-03.03

Code Language: "Sites shall be required to undergo and pass a City inspection upon completion of the installation of perimeter erosion and sediment controls, and upon completion of final stabilization."

Scope of Policy: This policy stipulates that site preparation inspections are required for Erosion and Sediment Control (ESC) permit holders that submit an ESC plan or an Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) for review. Site preparation inspections will be optional for permit holders not required to submit an ESC plan or SWPPP for review.

Policy:

A site preparation inspection, after installation of ESC controls, is required for all construction projects required to submit an ESC plan or SWPPP during the permit review process.

Sites that require an ESC plan and therefore a site preparation inspection are:

- Commercial construction: new projects, demolitions, and major tenant improvements
- Subdivision site development
- Hillside Zone residential (new and existing tenant improvements)
- Environmentally sensitive sites

(See Table 1)

New projects that do not require a site preparation inspection will be inspected by the ESC Division within the first month to check for compliance with the General Permit conditions.

If an ESC permit holder has questions regarding the ESC requirements, they can request an ESC inspection at any time during the project.

Intent: To provide clearer guidelines, for the public and city employees, on which projects require an ESC site preparation inspection.
