
Q1 Do you like the neighborhood where you live?



Q2 In your neighborhood, do you have access to the following things? Check all that apply.








Q4 If you had a choice, would you continue to live in your neighborhood or move to a different neighborhood?

Q5 If you want to live in a different neighborhood, are any of these things stopping you from moving? Check all that apply.






Q6 What types of housing do we need more of in Boise? Check all that are needed.








Q10 Do you know and understand your fair housing rights?


Q11 Do you know how to file a housing discrimination complaint?


Q12 How accessible are fair housing organizations in Boise?



Q14 Who do you believe discriminated against you? Check all that apply.










Q18 How satisfied were you with the outcome of filing a report of housing discrimination?









Q21 What best describes your current housing situation?



Q22 What is your race? Check all that apply.



Q23 Do you identify as Hispanic/Latinx?



Q24 What is your age?





Q26 What is the primary language you speak at home?




Q27 Which range best describes your annual household income?



Q29 Where do you live?


