

First Review Period:

- Permit takes approximately 2 to 3 working days to review a stand-alone Erosion and Sediment Control Permit.

- If an Erosion and Sediment Control Permit is tied to a Building Permit, the routing and review will occur under the applicable Building Permit review process.

- A Certified Responsible Person is required to implement and maintain best management practices on the site according to the permit and attached conditions.

- If Plan Waiver Request Letter is denied, an ESC Plan will be required for review. See the Erosion & Sediment Control Permit with ESC Plan flowchart for process.

- Plans are required to be prepared by a Boise City certified Plan Designer.

Submittal Information:

- Erosion and Sediment Control application
- Plan Waiver Request Letter

Applicant is notified that the Plan Waiver Request is not accepted and an Erosion and Sediment Control Plan is required to be submitted (See Erosion and Sediment Control Permit with ESC Plan Flowchart)
