



703 - Erosion and Sediment Control (ESC) Plan Waiver Request Form

For projects required to submit an ESC plan that have a low risk of erosion and stormwater runoff pollution, the applicant may request to waive the ESC plan requirement by submitting this form. If approved, the waiver request fee is \$78.75 in addition to the ESC permit fee.

NOTE: Erosion, sediment control and pollution prevention Best Management Practices (BMPs) must be implemented onsite as needed to comply with all ESC Permit requirements.
