

# **BUILDING PROCESS**



#### **DID YOU KNOW?**

Homeowners performing their own electrical work are required to complete a Conference Inspection prior to starting work. A rough-in inspection is required for all electrical permits before the final inspection. Inspections can be scheduled on the Permitting and Licensing System.

- 1. SUBMITTAL: Applications are submitted on the <u>City of Boise Permitting and Licensing system</u>. Applicants may relate the trade permit to a parent building record (For example- a home or commercial building project). Fees will be calculated based on the information provided. Additional contacts can be attached to the application at the time of submittal.
- 2. ISSUANCE: Fees will be assessed.
  The permit is issued automatically after payment, and the Applicant or additional contacts on the record can schedule inspections from the Record Detail Page.
- 3. INSPECTIONS: Inspections are scheduled by the applicant or contractor in the Permitting and Licensing system.

  Trade permits attached to a building permit must be finaled prior to the final building inspection taking place. Inspectors may require corrections.
