

## FISCAL YEAR 2019 ANNUAL VOLUNTEER REPORT



## **SUMMARY**

he city of Boise has one of the best park systems in the country, and our volunteers are a big reason why. This is especially true of this past year, during which thousands of people spent 71,662 hours caring for Boise parks and facilities and assisting with programming. This is equivalent to the department having over 34 additional full time staff and saved the department over \$1.5 million in labor costs.

Although the numbers are impressive, they do not fully represent what volunteers help us accomplish. The

We want to send a heartfelt thanks to all our volunteers. You play an important role in helping us stay connected to the community and the people we serve. We value the skills, input, and passion you bring to Boise Parks and Recreation, and consider ourselves lucky to work with such amazing people.

## **BREAKDOWN OF VOLUNTEER SERVICES**

This report is a summary of volunteer services during Fiscal Year 2019 (October 1, 2018—September 30, 2019). For the purposes of this report, we have broken up volunteer contributions into four categories.

**Annual & Special Events:** Volunteers that participate in or help coordinate department sponsored events.

**Boards & Committees:** Volunteers that serve on an advisory board, commission, or committee.

**Community Service:** Volunteers that assist department staff with field maintenance, as the result of a court-mandated sentence.

**Programs & Facilities:** Volunteers that assist with various programs and day-to-day operations of department facilities.

For Fiscal Year 2019 (FY 2019), we are crediting volunteer time at an hourly wage of \$22.14/ hour. This rate is based on the <u>Independent Sector's value of volunteer time</u> for the state of Idaho, the most recent year state-by-state rates have been calculated. The rate reflects the average hourly earnings of all production and non-supervisory workers on private non-farm payrolls (as determined by the Bureau of Labor Statistics), plus 12% to account for fringe benefits.

Community Service volunteer time is valued at \$11.33/hour. Volunteers that help in this capacity are credited at a lower rate, due to the fact that they assist the department to fulfill a sentencing requirement.

The following table illustrates where volunteers devoted their time in FY 2019, and sums up the extraordinary things volunteers helped us accomplish.
