Upper (C1-2, M1-2, Sunday A) – Has played high school or college baseball or softball and maintained these skills. Team often plays in tournaments at a high level and or travels for tournament play. Players can consistently turn double plays, hit multiple home runs a game and have a strong softball IQ.

Middle (C3-4, M3-6, Sunday B-D)– Players have played high school baseball or softball and have since seen skills diminish slightly. Team likes competitive play and participates in local tournaments at a fairly competitive level. Players can turn double plays at times and occasionally hit a home run or two.

Lowers (C 5-7, M7-9, Sunday E-G) – Players do not have a long history of playing softball or baseball or the players skills have significantly diminished over time. This division is for new, company, church or family teams where the purpose is less competitive and more of a fun activity for the group. Players in these divisions are still learning the fundamentals or have diminished skills. Players in this division rarely hit homeruns and seldomly turn double plays. This truly is a novice division.
